Free lending of communication equipment
related to the improvement of reception environment for distance learning

1. Eligible persons

Students who, due to financial reasons, do not possess or cannot use communication equipment in order to take distance classes. Concurrent application for the “Emergency interest-free scholarship for improving reception environment for distance learning” is allowed; however, the free lending of communication equipment and the loan scholarship for costs related to communication equipment are not available at the same time.

The number of available routers is limited. Please note that this initiative is for students who for financial reasons are unable to set up an internet environment and cannot use internet at home, or for students with extremely low available communication limit.

In case of a large number of applicants, priority will be given to those who are deemed to have the highest need, taking into consideration factors such as tuition exemption application status or scholarship application status; for the rest, decision will be made by lottery.

2. Communication equipment and conditions to lend

Equipment : Mobile router

Data limit : 150GB (1 month)

Fee: Free of charge (covered by the university)

Lending period: Until September 26, 2020 (Sat)

Limitations on purpose of use: Attending media classes conducted by Kyoto Institute of Technology

3. Application period

April 28 (Tue) ~ September 23 (wed) 17:00

4. Application documents/ Application method

Apply within the application period using the following Application Form.

5. How to lend/return

Lending: We will send it to the student’s address specified in the application form.

The mailing cost will be borne by the applicant (cash on delivery).

Return: Return by sending back to us by October 2. The mailing cost will be borne by the applicant (Payment in advance).

Provided that, if any of the following applies, it will be returned immediately.

- (1) When the student withdraws from university
- (2) When the student receives disciplinary action, etc. as prescribed in the university rules
- (3) When the application contains false facts
- (4) When used for purposes other than the purpose stated in 2.
- (5) When a fact exists that makes the student inappropriate for receiving this support
